### INVITATION FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

#### Senior Contracts and Procurement Consultancy Services (SCM)

Mozambique's oil and gas sector is entering a critical phase of large-scale development, encompassing multi-billion-dollar Engineering, Procurement and Construction (EPC) projects led by International Oil Companies (IOCs) and global contractors, notably the Mozambique LNG (TotalEnergies) and RLNG (ExxonMobil) Projects in the Rovuma Basin. These developments require robust governance, transparent procurement, and disciplined contract management in order to safeguard national value, ensure regulatory compliance, and guarantee sustainable local economic participation (local content).

In this context, the **National Petroleum Institute (INP)**, the upstream regulatory authority of Mozambique, intends to engage a **Senior Contracts and Procurement Consultant (SCM)** to provide independent, specialized, and strategic support in the review and regulatory approval of procurement and contracting processes submitted by the Concessionaires of Areas 1 and 4 of the Rovuma Basin, in accordance with Decree-Law No. 2/2014 of 31 December.

To this end, INP, acting as Contracting Authority, invites individual consultants and specialized firms, national or foreign, to submit an Expression of Interest for the provision of the aforementioned consultancy services. The Expression of Interest shall be accompanied by documentary evidence of technical, legal, economic-financial, and fiscal qualifications, or equivalent documentation for foreign entities. Additionally, candidates shall provide evidence of similar consultancy assignments and the curricula vitae of the proposed consultants.

Candidates shall meet the following minimum qualification requirements: (i) advanced academic degree in Engineering, Law, Supply Chain Management, or related field; (ii) a minimum of 10 to 15 years of proven experience in contracts and procurement in the oil and gas sector; (iii) proven experience managing EPC/EPCIC projects valued above USD 1,000,000,000 (one billion US dollars); (iv) prior engagement with governments, regulators, IOCs, and global EPC contractors; and (v) fluency in English (mandatory), with proficiency in Portuguese being an advantage. Recognized professional certifications (CIPS, ISM, WCC or equivalents) will be an asset.

The Expression of Interest and all required documents shall be submitted in Portuguese or translated into Portuguese by a sworn official translator, in triplicate, in a single sealed envelope clearly identified with the full name of the applicant and the subject of the procurement, to the address indicated below, **no later than 15h30 on May 1, 2026**.

The selection and the entire procurement procedure shall be conducted in accordance with the Regulations on Public Works Contracting, Supply of Goods and Provision of Services to the State, approved by Decree No. 79/2022 of 30 December.
